There is so much to learn from the director of Rennie Harris Pure Movement and founder of the Rennie Harris University certification course in Hip Hop and Street Dance history and pedagogy.
- **DNJ Vendors Market** Vendors ranging from shoemakers to dance attire to costume makers to massage therapists will be on hand to support dancers with needed items and wellness solutions
- **Community Roundtables** Our flex space will have a rotating roundtable focusing on K-12 Educators, Studio Owners, Not-for-Profits Organizations, and more.

- <u>Professional Development</u> K-12 educators, studio owners, college dance professionals, and independent teachers are invited to our biannual professional development workshops - Next stop = Renowned Tap artist **Jason Samuels Smith** - elevating a neglected black dance form at OCVTS this November 16!
- <u>Regranting Program</u> In partnership with the Covid Recovery Fund for Individual Dance Artists, NJ dance artists who demonstrate ongoing financial impact from the pandemic are eligible to apply for \$2000 personal grants
- <u>Biannual Connection Calls</u> Targeted connection and enrichment calls for member Educators, Non-Profits, and Studio owners
- <u>Main Street Concerts</u> we partner with business alliances and chambers of commerce around the state to activate downtowns/public spaces with live dance performances from our members
